Every Monday at 6:30 PM

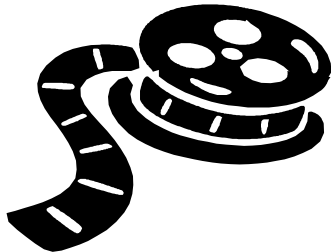

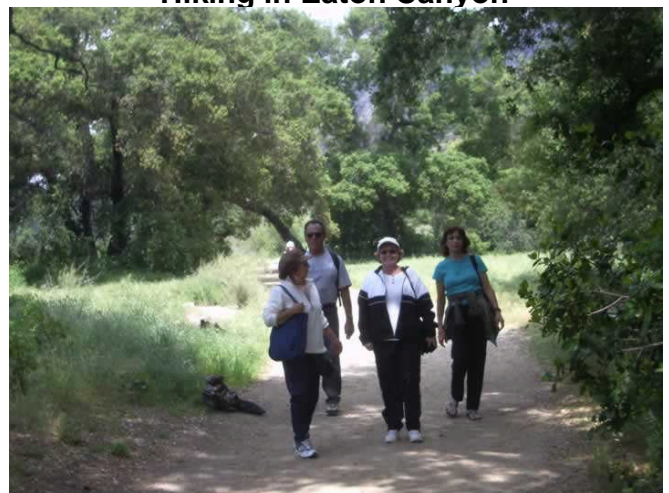
